Cookies - Definition and characteristics

A cookie is a file containing an identifier (a string of letters and numbers) that is sent from a web server to a web browser and is stored by it. The identifier is then returned to the server each time the browser requests a page from the server.

Cookies can be either "persistent" or "session" cookies: a persistent cookie is stored by a browser and remains valid until the set expiry date, unless it is deleted by the user before the expiry date; a session cookie, on the other hand, expires at the end of the user's session, when the browser is closed.

Cookies usually do not contain information that personally identifies a user, but the personal information we store about you may be linked to the information stored and obtained by cookies.

According to the laws in force in Italy, the use of cookies does not always require the express consent of the user. In particular, "technical cookies", i.e. those used solely to carry out the transmission of a communication over an electronic communications network or to the extent strictly necessary to provide a service explicitly requested by the user, do not require such consent. In other words, these are cookies that are essential to the functioning of the site or necessary for carrying out activities requested by the user. Among the technical cookies, which do not require express consent for their use, the Italian Data Protection Authority (see Measure Identification of simplified procedures for information and the acquisition of consent for the use of cookies of 8 May 2014 and subsequent clarifications, hereinafter only "Measure") also includes:

- the "cookie analytics" when used directly by the site operator to collect information, in aggregate form, on the number of users and how they visit the site,
- browsing or session cookies (for authentication),
- functionality cookies, which allow the user to navigate according to a series of selected criteria (for example, language, products selected for purchase) in order to improve the service provided to the same.

"Security" - we use cookies as part of the security measures we use to protect user accounts, including to prevent fraudulent use of login credentials and to protect our website and our services in general. The cookies used for this purpose are:
