# INFORMATION ON THE USE OF COOKIES

Pursuant to the existing legislation on the protection of personal data ("Privacy Legislation"), including EU Regulation 2016/679 ("GDPR") and the measures of the Italian Personal Data Protection Authority ("Privacy Protection Authority"), Reno de Medici S.p.A., as data controller ("RDM" or "Data Controller") provides users (hereinafter the "Users" or in the singular, the "Users") the following information relating to cookies installed on the domain <a href="https://www.rdmgroup.com">www.rdmgroup.com</a> (the "Website") and its subdomains that can be accessed via the Website.

#### What are cookies

Cookies are text and number files that are installed, whilst browsing a website, in the memory of the device (PC, smartphone or tablet) connected to the Internet via the browser application installed therein. These files allow information on browsing performed by the User on the Website to be gathered, in order to ensure the operation of the site and to improve the User's browsing experience.

Cookies can be stored permanently on the User's device (so-called "persistent cookies"), until the predetermined expiry (minutes, days, years), or they can be deleted automatically when closing the browser (so-called "session cookies").

Cookies can also be installed by the Website visited by the User (so-called "first-party cookies"), or they can be installed by other websites (so-called "third-party cookies").

#### Types of cookies used and related purposes

#### - Technical cookies

These cookies are used to ensure and facilitate activities strictly necessary for the operation of the Website, for the normal browsing on the same and to allow the related functions (such as, for example, saving the session, browsing preferences, recalling certain criteria selected such as language, managing the distribution of traffic, etc.) and to collect some information in aggregate form (anonymous) on Users.

The Website uses first-party technical cookies.

#### - Analytical cookies

These cookies are used to collect information on the use of the Website by Users (number of visitors, pages viewed, time spent on the Website, etc.).

The Website uses first-party and third-party analytical cookies.

## - Profiling cookies

These cookies are required to create User profiles in order to carry out actions in line with the preferences expressed by the User within the pages of the Website.

The Website uses first- and third-party profiling cookies

## - Profiling cookies - Social Media

These third-party cookies allow Users to interact with social networks (Facebook, Twitter, YouTube, Vimeo, etc.) and, in particular, to share the contents of the Website through said channels.

The Website does not use profiling cookies that allow interaction with social networks.

#### - Profiling cookies - Advertising

These third-party cookies allow to data and interests of visitors to be collected, in order to build, for each of them, a profile to be used for marketing purposes. In this way, Users will be able to receive personalised ads targeted on the basis of their interests.

The Website does not use profiling cookies that allow the User to be profiled for marketing purposes.

It should be noted that third-party cookies fall under the direct and sole responsibility of said third party. # Managing cookie preferences

At the time of first accessing any page of the Website, there is a banner that contains a brief information note. By continuing to browse, by accessing another area of the Website or selecting an element of the same (e.g., an image or a link), the User gives consent to the use of cookies.

Below, we show how to disable cookies directly by acting on the configuration settings of the main browser applications:

#### □ Internet Explorer

- 1. Open Internet Explorer;
- 2. Click on the "Tools" button and then on "Internet Options";
- 3. Select the "Privacy" tab and move the slider on the level of privacy that you want to set up (toward the top to block all cookies or downwards for allow all);
- 4. Then click on "Ok".

## □ Google Chrome

- 1. Open Google Chrome;
- 2. Click on the "Tools" icon;
- 3. Select "Settings" and then "Advanced Settings";
- 4. Select "Content Settings" under the "Privacy" tab;
- 5. In the "Cookie" tab, you can deselect cookies and save your preferences.

#### □ Firefox

- 1. Open Firefox;
- 2. Press the "Alt" button on the keyboard;
- 3. In the toolbar at the top of the browser, select "Tools" and then "Options";
- 4. Then select the "Privacy" tab;
- 5. Go to "Settings History" and then to "Use Custom Settings";
- 6. Deselect "Accept cookies from websites" and save your preferences.

#### □ Opera

- 1. Open Opera;
- 2. Click on the "Settings" menu of your browser and select "Settings";
- 3. Select "Quick preferences";
- 4. Deselect "Enable cookies";

#### □ Safari

- 1. Open Safari;
- 2. Choose "Preferences" in the toolbar, and then select the "Safety" panel in the dialogue box that follows:
- 3. In the section "Accept Cookies", you can specify if and when Safari must save cookies from websites. For further information, please click on the "Help" button (marked with a question mark);
- 4. For more information about cookies that are stored on your computer, click Show Cookies.

After these operations, however, some features of web pages may not be performed properly.

#### **Communication and Dissemination of data**

Data collected using cookies may be processed by our employees and collaborators as individuals authorised for processing pursuant to the Privacy Legislation.

Such data may also be processed by companies of our confidence that carry out, on behalf of RDM, technical and organisational tasks. These companies are our direct collaborators and operate under special deed of appointment as data processors.

The list of all appointed Data Processors involved in the processing operations via the Website is constantly updated and is available upon request by sending a notification to the email address RDM-GDPR@rdmgroup.com.

Personal data collected using cookies will not be transferred to third parties and will only be processed within the European Union. Where it is necessary to transfer data outside of the European Union, RDM will take care to make such transfers only in the presence of adequate guarantees pursuant to Article 46 et seq. of the GDPR.

Data collected using Google, LinkedIn and YouTube cookies, may be transferred from such third parties outside of the European Union, especially to the United States of America, in accordance with the Privacy Legislation. In each case, for more information, please visit the related cookie policies of Google, LinkedIn and YouTube.

Data collected using cookies will not be disseminated.

#### **User Rights**

Users are always entitled to the right of access to personal data, to request corrections, update if incomplete, incorrect or gathered in breach of the law, erasure and revoke, at any time, the consent given or to object to, or limit, their processing for legitimate reasons.

Except in the case where processing is necessary, Users also have the right to receive (or transmit directly to another data controller) personal data that concern them in a structured format, of common use and readable by automatic device, and request the erasure and/or destruction of said data.
